CSDS PROGRAM GUIDELINES FOR AGE & PLACEMENT:

Placement recommendations for all students is made by CSDS Directors & Faculty based on a personal combination of age, experience, and skill level.

- Children's Program: Age 2-6 Note age guidelines on schedule for all children's classes.
- Level I Age 6-8 suggested
- Level II Age 7-9 suggested
- Level III Age 9-11 suggested (includes Level III/IV classes)
- Level IV Age 10-12 suggested (includes Level III/IV and IV/V classes)
- Level V (Includes Teen) Age 11-13 suggested (includes Level IV/V classes)
- Level VI (Includes Teen) Age 12-14 suggested (includes Level VI/VII Tap class)
- Level VII (by recommendation only, min. 5 hrs/week) Age 13+ suggested (includes Level VI/VII Tap class)
- Specialty Classes: Pre-Pointe, Musical Theater, Hip Hop, Tumble, Production, Elite Technique: Refer to ages listed on class schedule
- **Ensemble Reps:** These Ensemble choreo classes will be assigned as part of the Ensemble Repertory casting process. Ensemble Dancers do not need to sign up for these at this time. They are only noted on the schedule for teacher planning purposes. All Ensemble Team dancers who signed up for reps will be included in the Season 23 Rep Program.

HELPFUL PLACEMENT GUIDELINES

- Level II through VII Choose your classes, but do not sign up for corresponding 'Ensemble Comp' spots. All classes will include a recital routine, and there is no additional sign-up required.
- Level II through VII ENSEMBLE TEAM: Choose your classes AND sign up for the corresponding 'Ensemble Comp' spot, 15-minutes following the corresponding technique class. If you wish to perform in competition you must sign up for the class AND the Comp chores 'class'. This additional 15-minutes is for dancers to learn and rehearse choreography that will eventually become the routine which will be performed on stage at competition and/or the CSDS recital.
- Level VI & VII POINTE DANCERS All students please sign up for Pointe Technique class AND the 15-minute Rep/Choreo spot. Each week students with either learn traditional classical repertoire accompanied by historic ballet references AND/OR lear choreography for upcoming comps, recitals, and performances.
- CHILDREN'S PROGRAM, Age 2-6: Please refer to the age guidelines listed on the class schedule. We welcome students of all levels, including absolute beginner! Please note the Wednesday 3:30 Creative Dance encourages students of all abilities to inquire about enrollment. This class is taught by CSDS Director, Miss Christina Certified Adaptive Dance instructor and welcomes children of all abilities in a suitable age range.
